Abstract:

Single-stranded DNA is a versatile construction material that can be programmed to self-assemble into nanoscale devices driven by the free energy of base pair formation. We are attempting to engineer DNA motors and sensors based on the manipulation of metastable states in the free energy landscapes underlying these systems.
